### He is despised and rejected by men,





### God doesn't look at your profession. He looks at your heart.





### God makes it very clear that He uses ordinary people to do extraordinary things. (others in your life and you in others' lives)



Remember, dear brothers and sisters, that few of you were wise in the world's eyes or powerful or wealthy when God called you.



Instead, God chose things the world considers foolish in order to shame those who think they are wise. And he chose things that are powerless to shame those who are powerful.



God chose things despised by the world, things counted as nothing at all, and used them to bring to nothing what the world considers important. As a result, no one can ever boast in the presence of God.



But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house."





### You don't need a seminary degree to follow Jesus



However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.



But people who aren't spiritual can't receive these truths from God's Spirit. It all sounds foolish to them and they can't understand it, for only those who are spiritual can understand what the Spirit means.

Then Jesus entered a house, and again a crowd gathered, so that he and his disciples were not even able to eat. When his family heard about this, they went to take charge of him, for they said, "He is out of his mind."

### Unbelief limits Jesus in my life



Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them. And He marveled because of their unbelief...





### Our lack of belief/faith in Jesus limits what He will do in your life



...if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.



And whoever will not receive you nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet as a testimony against them. Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!"

God doesn't really care about what you "say" you believe. Has your belief in Jesus led to repentance? Have you truly given your life to Christ?



Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.



For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables.

You can find "churches" that will just tell you what you want to hear. Be careful! If you are in a church that never makes you feel a little uncomfortable, then you are probably not in the right church.






