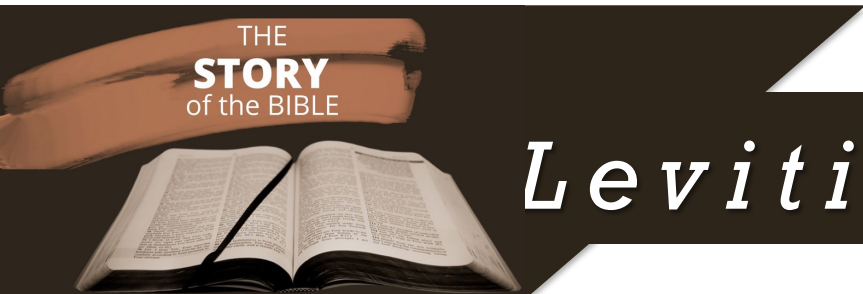

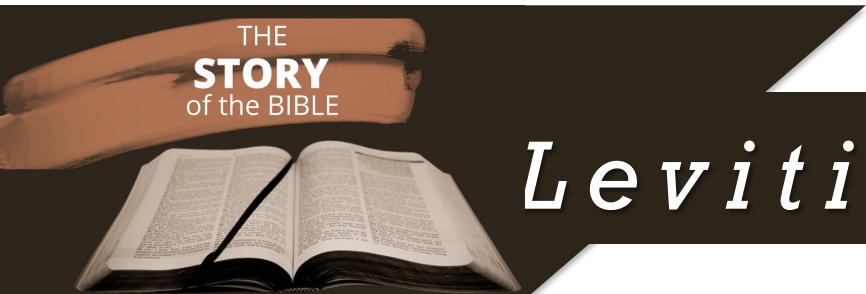
Speak to all the congregation of the people of Israel

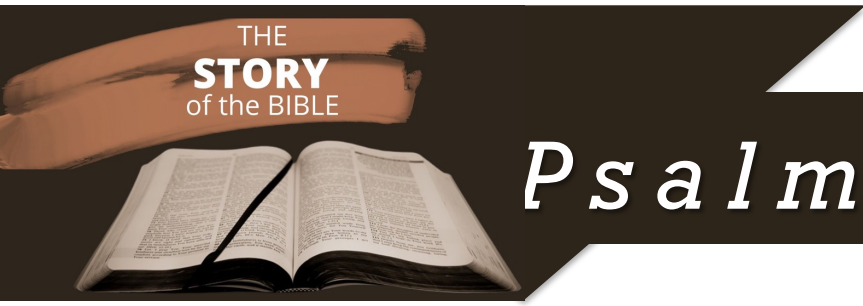

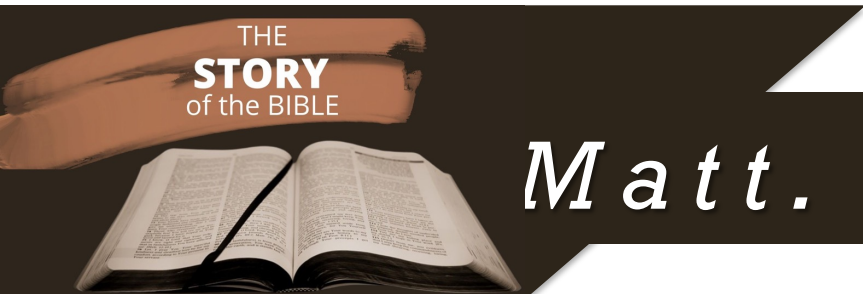

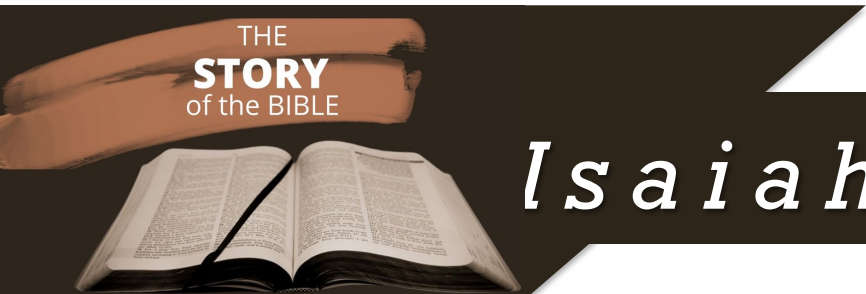

Let no one say when he is tempted, “I am being tempted by God,” for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one.

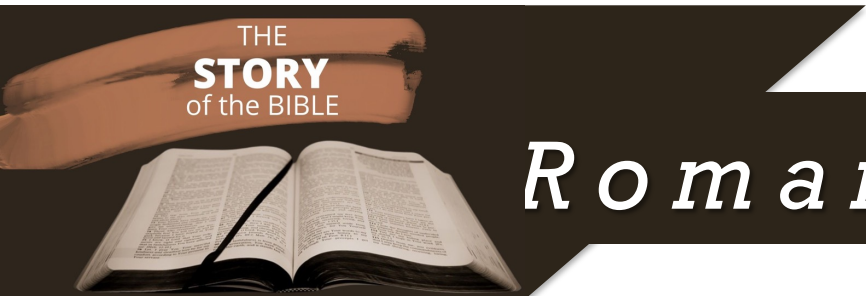

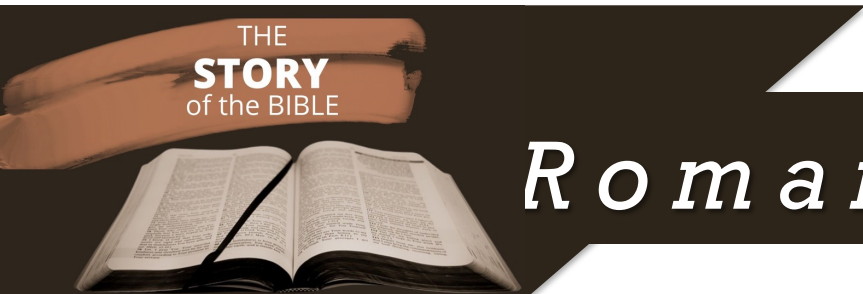
You will say to me then, “Why does he still find fault?

And one called to another and said:

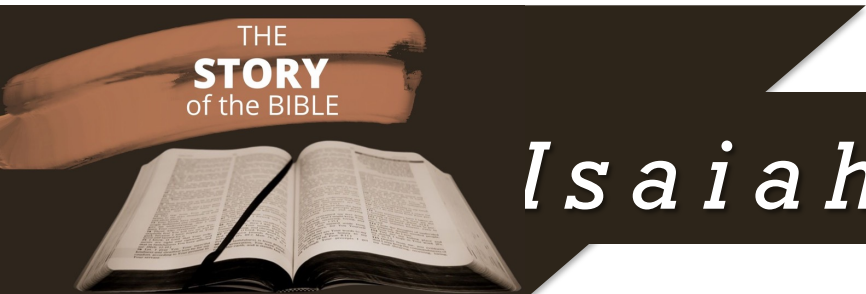
